



Review: Yes Oil-Based Organic Lubricant



A few days ago I realized something: while I've used plenty of water-based, silicone-based and hybrid lubricants in the past, I've never actually used an oil-based lube before. I found the idea pretty intriguing and worth a shot even if I didn't end up liking the consistency or overall feel of it. Maintaining a change of pace every now and again, especially when concerning my sex life, is key so it seemed like the right time for a change. Cruising the oil-based lube section can be a challenge, but I decided to gravitate towards an organic brand called [Yes](#) which sells a slew of other lubes as well.

When I first tried [Yes Oil-Based Organic Lubricant](#) I was a little skeptical about using the lubricant internally. I've heard countless stories about bacterial infections developing after using oil-based lubricants and it irked me enough to steer clear. I had a change of heart once I found out the formula was organic and hypoallergenic, free from miscellaneous content I can't even pronounce much less spell. Of course, even with organic ingredients that decision still poses a risk, depending upon how susceptible you are to infection — so use at your own discretion.

I don't say this to scare any of you away, it's just more a matter of intelligently weighing out the scenario and I'm happy to say I'm glad I took the jump. A little bit can go a very long way without ever becoming sticky or tacky. Unlike [silicone lube](#) which can be too slick sometimes, Yes was heavier and more rich in texture, a lot like butter actually. While oil-based lube does absorb into the skin it happens much slower than a [water-based](#), and leaves the skin feeling smoother than I've ever felt before from a lube. If that weren't enough, it also tastes pretty good too!

Yes can be used in a myriad of ways whether we're talking handjobs, blowjobs, vaginal or anal. It's comfortably smooth, even during long sessions, and does not require reapplying. Just remember to never use with latex condoms or any latex material, it will damage it.

There are a few different ways you can remove this heavy lube depending upon your tastes. First off, you can simply let it naturally absorb into the skin, leaving you feeling silky smooth, or you can

rub it off with a towel or scrubbed off in the shower (it doesn't immediately wash off so it's actually really good for water play). It's not always the easiest to remove, but it always leaves your skin feeling rejuvenated. Despite having such a heavy consistency, this lube didn't stain the sheets either so don't worry about any added fuss (that could be because of the organic ingredients, mind you).

Overall, Yes Oil-Based Organic was a nice surprise. It offered me everything I could want in a lube with little to no fuss. I'd still be cautious about using internally, especially if you're susceptible to infections, but if you're willing to take the jump like I did you might find yourself pleasantly surprised by the results.
